The Building Improvement Grant (BIG)

- Applications are now being accepted for the 2021 Building Improvement Grant. Applications can be found [here](#).
- The BIG is designed to incentivize property owners to undertake exterior property improvements, which will lead to increased property value and a better utilization of properties within downtown Fond du Lac. Grants are awarded based on the following criteria including, but not limited to: projected increase in property value, blight elimination, street front visibility, business track record, impact on surrounding neighborhood, a signed lease from a viable tenant, job creation, readiness to proceed, local economic impact, and new use of a high-profile property. - The Pop Up Fond du Lac program will go on hiatus due to our current location at 35 N. Main being permanently leased.
