The Building Improvement Grant (BIG)

- Applications are now being accepted for the 2022 Building Improvement Grant. Applications can be found <u>here.</u>
- The BIG is designed to incentivize property owners to undertake exterior property improvements, which will lead to increased property value and a better utilization of properties within downtown Fond du Lac. Grants are awarded based on the following criteria including, but not limited to: projected increase in property value, blight elimination, street front visibility, business track record, impact on surrounding neighborhood, a signed lease from a viable tenant, job creation, readiness to proceed, local economic impact, and new use of a high-profile property. If you are considering any improvements to your building façade, please contact <u>Amy Hansen</u> to begin the process of applying for a Building Improvement Grant.

Main Street Bounceback Grant

- Wisconsin Economic Development Corporation (WEDC) has announced the Main Street Bounceback Grant. The grant provides \$10,000 to businesses occupying previously vacant storefronts. Funds can be used to pay leases or mortgages, operational expenses and other business costs related to the newly opened location. Businesses need to be active commercial uses, be new or expanding businesses (not relocating) and to sign a 12-month lease or purchase a property between Jan. 1, 2021, and June 20, 2022.
