
The Wisconsin Seller's Permit Tucke

A seller's permit is a document from the Wisconsin Department of Revenue, for reporting and paying sales tax on what you sell. This resource is intended to be for vendors who only sell at temporary events and do not have a larger operation outside of temporary events.

You must assess your need for a seller's permit each year.
