#### **Business Notes**

#### **Downtown Parking**

 Did you know that when you park in a free Main Street parking space, you cost a downtown business \$200 a day in lost revenue? Your downtown friends and neighbors appreciate the effort you make to find parking off Main Street. Permits are affordable and convenient. Please call the City at (920) 322-3460 or visit 160 S. Macy. #### 2023 Grant Programs the DFP has introduced three new grant programs.

- **NEW Experience Generator Grant** -To continually increase the vibrancy and vitality of downtown, the 2023 Experience Generator Grant Program is designed to attract businesses who contribute to the overall downtown experience. These business types include restaurants, retail shops or experience-based business. Examples: Indoor archery, museums, ceramic art studios, golf simulators etc. The grant is for \$5,000 to assist with business startup expenses.
- **NEW New Business Grant** is an incentive to assist entrepreneurs with expenses associated with starting a new or expanding business. Businesses are eligible for a\$2,500 grant to be used towards startup expenses.
- **NEW Creative Sign Grant** is designed to incentivize property owners to undertake creative projecting sign projects that add to the uniqueness and character of Downtown Fond du Lac. The grant is specifically for unique, handcrafted projecting signs. The grant reimburses up to 75% of the cost of the sign design, manufacturing, and installation.
- The Building Improvement Grant (BIG) is designed to incentivize property owners to undertake
  exterior property improvements, which will lead to increased property value and a better utilization of
  properties within downtown Fond du Lac. The grant reimburses up to 50% of exterior remodeling
  expenses.
- The **Security Grant Program** assists property/business owners with purchasing an exterior surveillance camera system (in partnership with the Fond du Lac Police Department) and/or a rapid entry system lock box (in partnership with the Fond du Lac Fire Department). The program reimburses up to \$250 per exterior camera.

#### **Special Event Applications**

- Special event applications for <u>Farmers Market</u>, <u>Fondue Fest</u> and <u>Night Market</u> are now available on the DFP <u>website</u> and at the DFP office.
- All businesses located within the BID are eligible to participate in the Farmers Market (one space) and Fondue Fest (two spaces) for free.

#### **Downtown Fond du Lac Farmers Market**

- The Downtown Fond du Lac Farmers Market began on Saturday, May 20 and will run through Saturday, October 28. Main Street will be closed from 6:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. weekly between Forest Avenue to Western Avenue.
- All downtown businesses are eligible to receive one free space at the Farmers Market. Applications are available on the DFP <u>website</u>. Printed copies are available at the DFP office.
- Several downtown businesses have worked together to organize a shopping promotion in partnership with the Farmers Market sponsor Grande Cheese.
- Shop downtown businesses during the Farmers Market and SAVE. All you need to do is pick up a
  Grande tote bag from the information tent located at 131 S. Main Street during the Farmers Market
  and bring it to a participating downtown business to redeem the savings. Savings can only be
  redeemed on Saturdays during the Farmers Market. Participating businesses and offers are subject to

#### Night Market

- The final Night Market will take place on August 24, from 5:00 p.m. 8:00 p.m. Main Street will be closed between Division Street to Forest Avenue, including Sheboygan Street to Portland Street from 3:00-9:00 p.m.
- The mission of the Downtown Fond du Lac Night Market is to draw positive attention to the downtown business district while fostering community collaborations through art, music and experiences.
- Attendees can expect to see fresh produce, prepared foods, local artists, and live music all while
  enjoying a cold beverage. Kids can enjoy playing the outdoor games that will be available at each
  event. Enjoy the Night Market before you stroll down to Thelma Sadoff Center for the Arts 13
  Thursdays of Summer Concert Series.

#### **Fondue Fest**

  take place between Merrill Street and Western Avenue, also on the side streets between Macy Street
  and Marr Street.
