BUSINESS NOTES

- **Yakuub's Korner** is open at 18 Forest Ave. They offer video games, from Atari to PS5, professional disc cleaning, sports jerseys, cards and more.
- **Dungeon Krew Fitness** is open at 73 S. Main Street. They specialize in personal training and group self-defense and other fitness classes.
- **The Reiki Room** will be opening within the Beauty Republic & Co. space at 131 S. Main St. in July. They will specialize in Reiki Massage.
- **Tantrum** – Fond du Lac's first "rage room", will be opening at 44 N. Main Street in the coming months. They have been approved for an Experience Generator Grant.
- A Building Improvement Grant was approved for new windows at **Aurora's Apothecary** at 171 S. Main.

2024 GRANT PROGRAMS

- **Experience Generator Grant** – Designed to attract businesses who contribute to the overall downtown experience by increasing the vibrancy and vitality of the downtown district, the 2023 Experience Generator Grant Program provides new downtown businesses with funding associated with business startup costs. Eligible business types include restaurants, retail shops, or experience-based businesses such as indoor archery, museums, ceramic art studios, golf simulators, etc. This program provides a \$5,000 grant to assist with business startup expenses.
- **New Business Grant** – Designed to incentivize and assist entrepreneurs with expenses associated with starting a new or expanding business, this program provides a \$2,500 grant to eligible businesses to be used towards startup expenses.
- **Creative Sign Grant** – Designed to incentivize property owners to add to the uniqueness and character of Downtown Fond du Lac by undertaking creative projecting sign projects. This program grants up to 75% reimbursement of the cost to design, manufacture, and install a unique, handcrafted projecting sign.
- **Building Improvement Grant (BIG)** – Designed to increase property values and support better utilization of properties within downtown Fond du Lac, this grant program incentivizes and assists property owners in making exterior property improvements. The grant reimburses up to 50% of the cost of exterior remodeling expenses.
- **Security Grant Program** – Developed to assist property/business owners with purchasing an exterior surveillance camera system (in partnership with the Fond du Lac Police Department) and/or a rapid entry system lock box (in partnership with the Fond du Lac Fire Department). The program reimburses up to \$250 per exterior camera, and 50% of the cost of each lockbox.

With an annual attendance of more than 25,000 people, Fond du Lac's largest one-day festival returns in 2024, courtesy of Fox Valley Savings Bank. The festival will feature multiple stages with all genres of live music, a huge Kids Zone sponsored by SSM Health, art, craft, prepared food, and produce vendors, and cheese and chocolate fondue from MPTC Culinary Arts students.

EVENT RECAPS

- **2024 Downtown Fond du Lac Farmers Market** - Sponsored by SSM Health, the 2024 Farmers Market has started off strong attracting large numbers of attendees and vendors, even on poor weather dates. There are currently 152 vendor applications submitted, putting the DFP on track to reach record vendor numbers by the end of the season.
- **2024 Summer Wine Walk** - Sponsored by National Exchange Bank & Trust, the 9th Annual Summer Wine Walk was a success. 525 ticket holders were given the opportunity to taste up to 12 samples of various sweet wines, dry wines, or mocktails and NA beverages served by 19 participating downtown businesses.

- **Retailworks Workshop** – On Thursday, June 13th, the DFP hosted a downtown business workshop with Retailworks, Inc. - an award-winning commercial interior design, display, branding, and consulting firm headquartered in Milwaukee, WI – who provided insight, education and training on best practices for storefront and retail design. - **WEDC Website/Social Media Audit Opportunity**

As businesses located within a Wisconsin Main Street Community, Downtown Fond du Lac businesses are eligible to receive free website and social media audits from Wisconsin Main Street's downtown promotions manager. This assistance focuses on reviewing, evaluating, and assessing the business' website and/or social media pages.

Potential reasons for a website or social media audit:

- Looking to revamp your website.
- Looking for an outside perspective on website updates.
- Looking to revamp your social media accounts.
- Need help with social media content ideas.
- Need help with social media post frequency.
- Need an outside perspective on how your employee is doing with social media content.
- Taking over a pre-existing website/social media account and wanting help on how to revamp and/or how to make it better.

- **Destination Lake Winnebago Region (DLWR) Community Identity Program Micro-grant**

DLWR is offering a one-time micro-grant opportunity to up to 50 businesses located in Fond du Lac and Waupun. The purpose of the micro-grant is to integrate the suggestions proposed as part of the Community Assessment Program performed by Roger Brooks International, a project funded by Destination Lake Winnebago Region, by assisting business owners in obtaining small placemaking and welcoming assets that will make the business entrance inviting to consumers, motivating them to spend more time at the business and spend money on business products.

Funds will be distributed on a first-come first-served basis from March 1st, 2024 through October 31, 2024, or until funds are exhausted.
